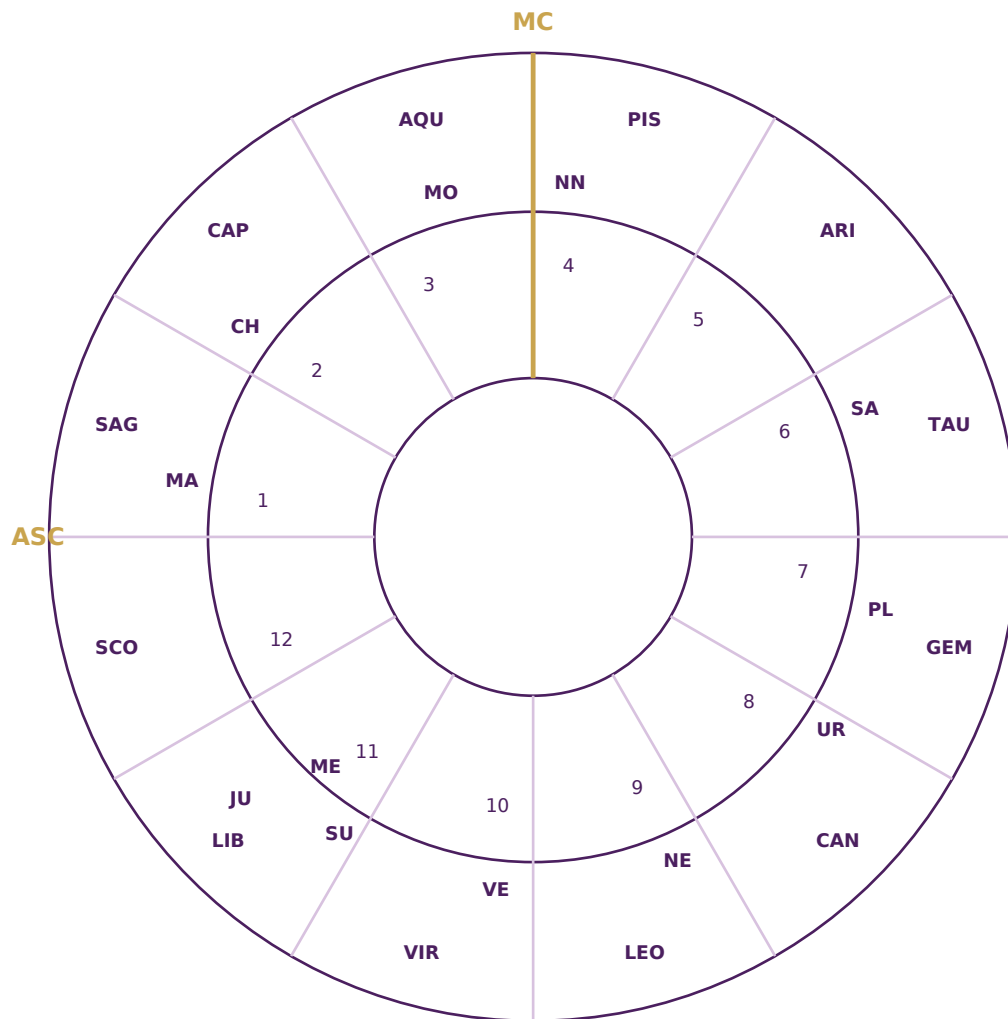
How to use this report
