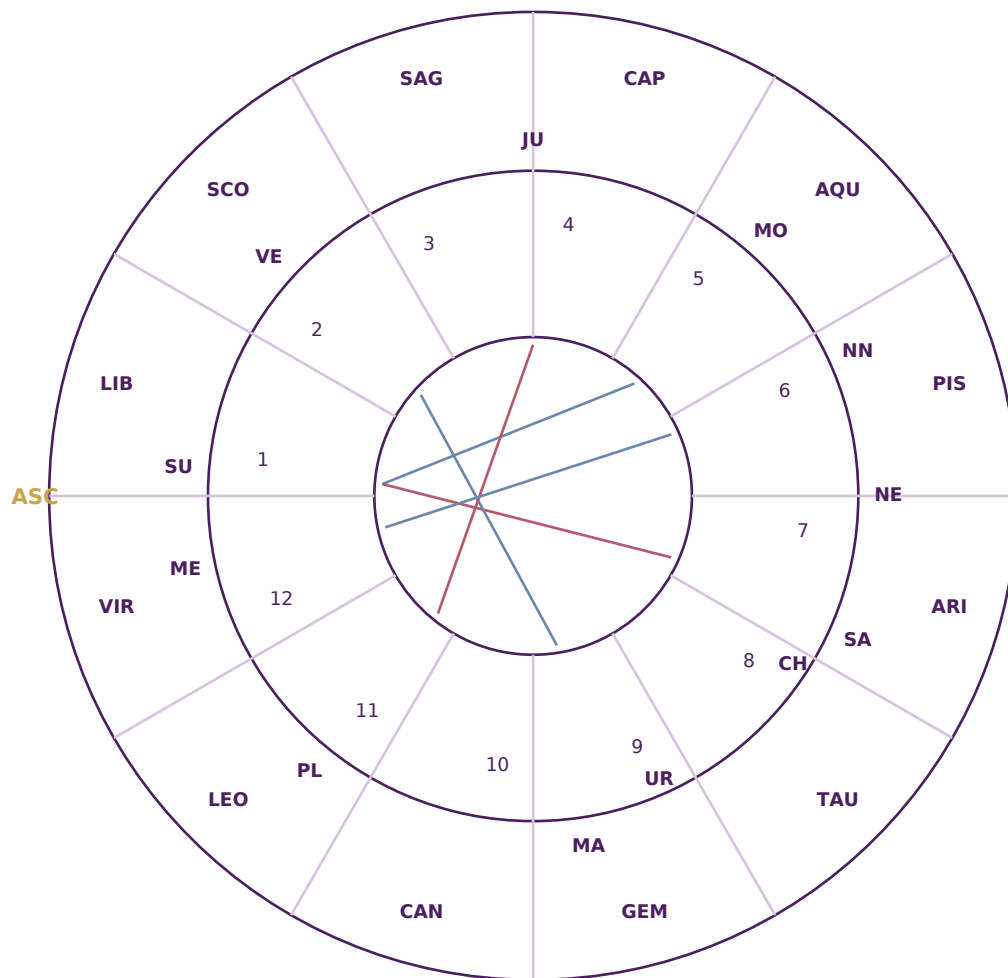
Your exact return

March 25, 2027 - Midyear

June 25, 2027 - Final quarter

Complete what matters, release unnecessary obligations and gather the wisdom you want to carry into the next birthday cycle.
